The Prompt Engineer's Pack List

A calm, simple guide to the tools that make prompting easier.

You don't need advanced setups or technical skills to prompt well. This Pack List includes a few optional tools that support clarity, clean workflows, and smooth everyday use.

Use what helps. Ignore what doesn't.

SECTION 1

Your Core Tools (Essentials)

1. GPT-5.1 (ChatGPT)

Your primary model for reliable, consistent prompting.

Best for: learning, writing, analysis, creativity, and general problem-solving.

2. Document Upload Support (PDF/Text/Images)

Allows you to summarize, extract key points, and ask detailed questions about long content.

3. A Clean Writing Space (Any Simple Editor)

Examples: Google Docs, Word, iA Writer, Notepad.

Helpful for drafting prompts clearly before sending them.

4. A Note App for Your Prompt Library

Examples: Apple Notes, Notion, Obsidian, Google Keep.

Use this to store reusable prompts, templates, and ideas.

SECTION 2

Optional Helpers (Nice to Have)

5. Official ChatGPT Browser Extension

Lets you capture and send text from webpages directly into the model.
Useful for summarizing articles or researching.

6. Simple Clipboard Manager (Optional)

Helps you keep track of multiple prompts or drafts while refining them.
Any OS or browser-based manager works.

7. File Storage (Google Drive / Dropbox / iCloud)

Useful for organizing your prompt systems and reference documents.
